



# **GUARDIANS:** Europe's flagship project to address nuclear crises

Paris, October 2025 – The European Union has launched GUARDIANS, a strategic project under the Horizon Europe – Cluster 3 "Disaster-Resilient Societies" programme (Grant Agreement number 101225744). Its objective is to strengthen Member States' ability to anticipate, manage, and mitigate the consequences of a nuclear crisis. Coordinated by the CEA, this four-year project (2025–2029) will develop an integrated decision-support platform, GUARDNET for public authorities and frontline responders to improve the response organisations at different level (local, national and international).

In a context marked by the risks of reactor accidents, large-scale contamination, and geopolitical tensions affecting nuclear infrastructures, GUARDIANS brings together an unprecedented combination of:

- innovative and cost-effective Nuclear and Radiological detection technologies, robotics, medical triage tools, and protective measures,
- crisis-management methodologies and societal studies,
- table-top and field exercises.

## A unique pan-European consortium committed for four years

The project brings together **22 partners** from **11 EU Member States and associated countries**, along with one Ukrainian partner, united by a shared ambition: strengthening the protection of first responders, populations and critical infrastructures facing Nuclear and Radiological risks.

The consortium brings together a uniquely diverse and complementary partnership:

- 5 Research and Technology Organisations (RTOs) (CEA, ENEA, HUN-REN EK, IFE, PIB)
- 5 universities (UCBL, NKUA, UCSC, EASS, VU),
- 6 innovative SMEs (CAEN, OUVRY, ISYMAP, NUVIA, EXTENSEE, RAN),
- 1 industrial major security-detection company (KNDS),
- 1 group of end-users, including a nuclear safety authority (ASNR), first responders (SDMIS, APOZ, FRC, EASS), a major receiving hospital (UCSC), and a local authority (CC).

This multidisciplinary composition ensures direct alignment with operational needs and a strong capacity for technological transfer.

## A major European investment for operational and field-ready solutions

**GUARDIANS** represents a significant investment aimed at equipping Europe with operational, validated, and field-adapted solutions to better protect populations and critical infrastructures against emerging nuclear risks.
